Objective

The aim of this course is to bring PhD candidates and Postdocs, who have finished the complete A1 beginner level of the Common European Framework of Reference, up to the A2 elementary level.

Description

This is the **first** part of the course A2, which we offer in two modules: A2-1 and A2-2. After the completion of **both modules**, i.e. the full A2 course, you will be able to:

- understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of most immediate relevance (e.g. very basic personal and family information, shopping, local geography, employment),
- communicate in simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and routine matters,
- describe in simple terms aspects of your background, immediate environment and matters in areas of immediate need,
- use basic grammatical structures: e.g. signals for subordinate clauses, past tense, subjunctive.
